Dear SPA Family,

I would like to introduce you to the missionary for Mission Co-Op Sunday (May 25/26). **Fr. Maciej (Matthias) Fleszar** was my classmate at a seminary in Poland. We studied together in my home diocese for four years. Father Maciej, aged 45, after graduating from the High School of Fine Arts, he entered the Higher Seminary in Tarnów. The painting here depicting the church in my town, was painted by him during a break between classes in the seminary. Following his ordination, he served as a vicar among the Cracovian community in Zaborów and among the Highlanders in Ochotnica Dolna.

Influenced by reading the Pope Francis's apostolic exhortation "The Joy of the Gospel" and visiting the empty tomb of Jesus in Jerusalem, he asked his bishop to send him to an underdeveloped part of the world. After two years of language and cultural preparation in Poland and France, he was sent to the **Republic of Congo**, where he was entrusted with building the parish of St. John Paul II in the capital city of Brazzaville. This parish is located in one of the neglected districts of the city without access to water and electricity. The construction plan for this parish, which has about five thousand faithful parishioners, includes not only the parish church itself but also a vocational school and a medical clinic which was designed by himself.

Thanks to the involvement of the local community and the assistance provided to Father Maciej by his compatriots from Poland and the USA, the school building has already been erected. Only the construction of the church and clinic remains, for which this year's **Mission Co-Op** Appeal at St. Paul the Apostle aim to contribute. On behalf of Father Maciej Fleszar and his parishioners, half of whom are young adults and children, I invite you to support the construction of this living monument to the Polish Pope,

who also saw the future of the Church and the world in Africa. Have a blessed week, Fr. Chris



GOSPEL MEDITATION



Once I was at a meeting with representatives of various religions. On a coffee break, a man from another religion mused to me: "You know, with all our differences, all religions are really about being good people." I lowered my cappuccino and said as warmly as I could, "That's not what mine's about." His quizzical look begged for clarification. "Mine is about plunging into the life of God," I said.

Just before Jesus ascends into heaven, he commands the eleven apostles, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20). The word "baptize" means "to immerse in, to plunge into." It presupposes the use of water. But what does it mean to be immersed in God's name? In the Bible, God's name is identical to God Himself. So, to be baptized into water, using Jesus' formula, is to be plunged into the life of God. Said another way, it is to die with Jesus and rise with him as a member of his body.

The Trinity isn't a doctrine simply to accept and ponder. It's more like an ocean: a mystery into which we are baptized ... inserted, immersed, dunked, plunged. Baptism gives us power to live our lives as beloved children of God, patterned after Jesus himself, who is always with us, until the end of the ages. Hardly the same as being good people. Stranger, but much better.

- Small Furniture: end tables, coffee tables, small chairs, TV stands, etc.


Please note: We will not be able to accept mattresses, box springs, stuffed animals, toys, baby car seats, cribs, strollers, baby bedding and accessories.


