SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT- JUST TAKE NOTICE...

It was a cool September morning when I headed outdoors to walk. Though I would have encouraged our grandchildren to wear jackets to school that day, I left my hoodie home. My brisk pace would keep me warm. As I walked, I pondered this writing. I also reminded myself to prepare a notice for the parish bulletin. Francis of Assisi's feast day is October 4, and, as is our custom, our parish will celebrate by blessing pets the Sunday before (October 2 at 1:30). I laughed as I walked because I'd already passed four dogs with their owners during the ten minutes I'd been out. Last fall, one of the things I noticed about our new neighborhood was that we're surrounded by dog owners. Happily, I also discovered that their pets are well-trained and quite friendly. By the end of my 45-minute walk, I'd passed thirteen human-and-dog duos.

At home, I thought back to Mike's and my one and only dog. We and Ernie would never have met the local standards of pet ownership! Our difficulties began during the drive home from the pet shop. Our cocker-beagle-poodle-terrier puppy refused to stay put. He repeatedly crawled out of the box on my lap that he was supposed to occupy for the trip home. Mike and I were married only ten months when we met Ernie. We were also both teachers who managed our students quite well. Sadly, we weren't as successful with Ernie. Poor Ernie failed doggie kindergarten because his owners failed to practice commands and reward successes with consistency. We (Okay, I) thought everything Ernie did was cute. Fortunately, Ernie was saved by a good friend who told us that we were terrible parents! Judy generously took Ernie into her care. During just a few afternoon sessions, Judy taught Ernie everything he needed to know. She taught his owners a few things as well! In the end, Ernie wasn't perfect, but he was far more well-behaved than Mike and I deserved him to be.

During our fourteen years together, Ernie taught us far more than we taught him. Ernie's initial lack of discipline helped us not to make the same mistakes with our children. We refined our parenting skills while dealing with him. Still, despite sacrificing himself for our kids, Ernie loved us unconditionally and he seemed quite content to be our pet. Perhaps Ernie's greatest attribute was his sensitivity to just about everything around him. He knew the mail carrier approached though he or she wasn't on our block yet. Ernie growled quietly long before I noticed strangers nearby. Ernie also paced in anticipation of Mike's arrival every evening after work even before the garage door opened.

Ernie sensed when a crying baby had woken me too often on a given night. As I sat nursing my little son, Ernie nuzzled at my feet. "You're not alone," he seemed to say. When the extended family visited, Ernie made a beeline to my stepdad. How did Ernie know that Bill was a dog-lover? When Mike's father passed away, Ernie sensed Mike's sadness. He climbed onto the couch next to him seemingly knowing that Mike needed him. When Mike was away for a late night meeting or out of town, Ernie slept on the floor next to my side of the bed to assure me that he was keeping watch. Yes, Ernie tended to the details of this life quite carefully.



Today, we hear Jesus' parable (Luke 16:19-31) of the rich man who missed too much of what transpired around him. The man spent his time and his wealth on himself. He enjoyed lavish feasts while a poor man lay dying on his doorstep. The rich man was so taken with his own luxuries that he failed to notice many other people who might have graced his life, especially those in need. Only the neighborhood dogs noticed that dying man. They tended to his suffering as best they could by licking his wounds. Did Ernie's canine counterparts somehow know that Lazarus might have recovered if his rich neighbor had only noticed him and cared for him?

In the end, Jesus shared that both men passed into eternal life. There, Lazarus rested in Abraham's embrace, while the rich man wallowed in suffering. When that rich man begged Abraham to send Lazarus to him with a few drops of water, Abraham couldn't comply. The abyss between the two men was simply too great. If the rich man had only noticed his suffering neighbor, life would have been much better for both of them. If the rich man had found a way to help Lazarus, he would also have found his way to Abraham's embrace.

I admit that Ernie drove me crazy some of the time. However, I also admit that Ernie comforted Mike and me far more often. That little dog showed us that a well-timed nuzzle, sufficient food, a safe place to lay his head and the encouraging love of those who cared for him were all he needed. All that any of us need to be happy is the same. So it is that, once again, we're invited to take notice of the people we've been given to love and to care for them as only we can.
