#### SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT- DANCE WITH CHRISTMAS JOY!

A few weeks ago, we gathered to celebrate my husband, our younger son and our youngest granddaughter. That day, it was quite easy for me to live up to my resolve to bring a bit of Christmas Joy to every day of Advent 2022 because it felt like Christmas to me. In my mind, or shall I write "in my heart", there's nothing better than spending time with Mike and our sons, our daughters-in-law, and our grandchildren all under one roof. Their lively chatter is music to my ears. Their smiles are the frosting on the cake. That day, in the midst of our revelry, my granddaughter began to dance.

Though her parents are great dancers, Ellie has surpassed their skills. As a little girl, she celebrated moments of joy by twirling on her tiptoes as only a preschooler could. Since then, years of dance classes and her own persistence have resulted in her truly amazing footwork. Ellie can break into a hip hop routine or glide across the room like a ballerina depending upon her mood. Apparently, she'd embraced the joy I felt because she embellished her demonstration with enthusiastic jubilance. Honestly, if I had any talent at all in this regard, I would have danced with her!



to joy which is great enough to elicit a dance. In today's first reading, Isaiah (1:1-10) described the day when One would come who is filled with "...a spirit of wisdom and of

understanding, a spirit of counsel and of strength." He would transform this suffering world into God's holy mountain where peace and joy reigned. I'd love to dance just once in such a place!

Matthew's gospel (3:1-12) tells us that John the Baptist emerged from the desert after months of prayer and reflection. He'd made Isaiah's message his own. John's enthusiasm was so great that throngs of people came to listen and to be baptized by him. Even Pharisees and Sadducees sought baptism, perhaps as a safety measure in the event that John spoke the truth! How could they not dance with joy over John's good news?

In his letter to the Romans (15:4-9), Paul encouraged our family's November birthdays. These included the people to recognize that Jesus was indeed the one who offered everything that Isaiah's and John's audiences had hoped for. Paul pointed out that, because his followers had seen, heard and touched Jesus for themselves, they had no choice but to rejoice. Might we break into dance if you and I fully embraced what Jesus has to offer as well?

> Now, as it happened, Isaiah lived a difficult life which tradition tells us likely ended in his being sawn in two. Eleven apostles were martyred because they preached Jesus' message.



Saint Paul was beheaded for the same. We know too well the details of Jesus' death. There isn't much to dance about in any of this. Nonetheless, two weeks ago, we celebrated The Feast of Christ the King. We focused upon Jesus' last moments when he offered God's peace and joy to a most unlikely recipient. While passersby jeered at Jesus and one of the criminals who hung with him ridiculed him, Jesus' second companion in death simply asked for mercy. Overcome with love, Jesus dismissed his own suffering to dance the dance of compassion. Jesus offered this criminal ultimate joy -his own dance into eternity.

Now, I realize it's unlikely that Isaiah and Paul, I share this because our Advent the apostles and the man crucified next to Jesus danced scriptures offer frequent references much during their earthly lives. Though Jesus knew the outcome of his work, it's unlikely that he ever danced as he approached the streets of Capernaum or Jerusalem where crowds awaited him. Though my heart dances every time our family gathers, I don't physically dance my way to console an ailing friend, to attend a funeral, to buy gas or groceries, or to do laundry. I don't even dance into church! Yet, like Isaiah, Paul, and the man on the cross who asked Jesus to remember him, I have reason to dance, and so do you.

> My granddaughter's response to our being together was to dance. Jesus' love impelled him to dance with compassion regardless of his own suffering. Jesus' example invites us to dance with love as well. Like Jesus, we'll find the courage to dismiss our own concerns long enough to turn to those who need us. Though our legs may not move in choreographed fashion, our hearts will dance into every opportunity to love just as Jesus did. Each time, we'll find ourselves one step closer to Christmas Joy!

Simbang Gabi or "Night Mass" is a nine-day series of Masses leading up to Christmas Eve. In 1669, during Spanish rule over the Philippines, priests began to say Mass in the early mornings instead of the evening novenas more common in the Hispanic world. This was a practical compromise for farmers, who began work before sunrise to avoid the noonday heat out in the fields. Parol, star-shaped lantern, was used by worshipers to guide their way. This cherished Christmas custom eventually became a distinct feature of Philippine culture and became a symbol of sharing.




